

*In 2011, Becky Tillson of the Jackson Hole Conservation Alliance began airing “Comp Plan Uncomplicated,” a series of impartial and informative radio shows about the ongoing revision of the Jackson/Teton County Comprehensive Plan. The shorter segments initially air on KHOL, Jackson Hole’s community radio station (89.1 FM), on Wednesdays at 4 p.m., and then play again on Thursdays at noon and Sundays at 10 a.m. Here are links to recordings of all of the shows, listed in order of most recent first:*
