If you don't already know of her, McIntosh is a favorite Jackson Hole-based singer/songwriter who has released several CDs with her hauntingly beautiful tunes that have been called a “combination of Nanci Griffith's singing and Bruce Cockburn's guitar playing.” McIntosh has crossed the nation – and recently toured Scotland – sharing her guitar rhythms and voice.
